## Dear colleagues,

The Spanish Entrepreneurship Research Group at the University of Huelva and the The Cátedra Extenda de Internacionalización (Consejería de la Presidencia, Administración Pública e Interior, Junta de Andalucía) will hold a Workshop in Internationalization and Entrepreneurship in El Rompido, Huelva, Spain, on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2019.

The workshop is intended to present and discuss new frontiers in the research on internationalization and entrepreneurship especially in light of advances in technology, demographic changes, increasing trade conflicts, secular stagnation and the productivity slowdown, and the greater availability of data. We are therefore inviting submissions of papers that deals amongst others with the following research questions/topics:

- The changing impact of internationalization on economic and business dynamism.
- Digital entrepreneurship, international trade and new modes of internationalization.
- Changing patterns of early internationalization across time and across countries.
- The impacts of the global financial crisis on international entrepreneurship after a decade.
- New modes of finance and the internationalization behaviour of firms.
- Barriers to the internationalization of SMEs/Institutions.
- The (increasing) importance of international knowledge flows for entrepreneurship.
- International entrepreneurship and development in low-income countries.
- Role of multinationals for fostering entrepreneurship.
- The future of work and its implications for transnational entrepreneurship.
- Female international entrepreneurship.
- Ageing, entrepreneurship and internationalization.
