<b>Nomination/ Application Overview</b>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Nomination email from the partner institution including the following student info: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Name and Surname</li> <li>E-mail</li> <li>Field of study</li> <li>Length of exchange (1st Semester, 2<sup>nd</sup> semester or Full Year).</li> </ul> </li> <li>Confirmation of Acceptance from UHU. Welcome information package sent by email to the student.</li> <li>Students will have to complete a pre-registration form in our mobility program <a href="#">UMove</a>.</li> <li>All documents will be done through <a href="#">UMove</a> (letters of Acceptance, Learning Agreements, etc.).</li> </ol>
<b>UMove</b>	All mobility procedures will be done through our mobility software <a href="#">UMove</a> . Please read carefully our <a href="#">UMove Manual</a> to register in our system and complete your Learning Agreement.

<b>Accommodation</b>	<p>There are lots of renting possibilities here in Huelva for most budgets, ranging from student rooms in residence halls to shared flats. For your convenience, we recommend renting a flat in the city center or near the Campus El Carmen (Los Rosales, Fuentepiña, Avenida Andalucía, ...)</p> <p>You have two options when searching for a flat in Huelva:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Temporary accommodation for the first days while looking for a permanent flat or room.</li> <li>2. Long- term accommodation: Book a room or flat online, or once you arrive in Huelva.</li> </ol> <p>Each option has advantages and disadvantages, so consider which one better suits your needs and budget. <b>Average cost of accommodation</b>	Usually between 200€ - 250€ per student per month in shared flat with own bedroom (bills included).
<b>Aprox. cost of living per month for students</b>	450€ - 500€ (possibly less) should cover all expenses: rent, bills, food, transport, etc.
<b>Healthcare</b>	Students should have the European Health Card or a private insurance (without one of these, you will not be allowed to register).
<b>Food services</b>	There is 1 University Canteen + 4 Bar/ Cafeterias. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Menu: 6,55€</li> <li>• Cafetería Tapas 2,00€ - 2,50€</li> <li>• Bono menu: 10 meals, 62€</li> </ul>
