The Jabugo Route takes place in the Natural Park Sierra de Aracena and Picos de Aroche, The Jabugo Route lets us diver the acorn-fed 100% Iberian pig world, from its natural environment in the ancient Dehesas (pasturelands), to the artisan cellars, where the artisan maturing process with Protected Designation of Origin (PDO) Jabugo ends.



PROTECTED DESIGNATION OF ORIGIN (PDO) JABUGO HOUSE.

We will visit The Protected Designation of Origin (PDO) Jabugo House, located in a monumental building in the village of Jabugo, to know the requirements that the product has to fulfill to become a product protected by that institution. This visit takes us to an emblematic and singular building full of history, a palace built at the beginning of the twentieth century designed by the famous architect Anibal Gonzalez.







RITUAL OF THE CUT OF A JABUGO HAM AND SENSORY TASTE

At the Jabugo holm oak (House of the Regulatory Council of the Protected Designation of Origin Jabugo) we will have the opportunity to enjoy a Sensory Jabugo Ham Tasting by a Master Carver, who will also show us The Jabugo ham Cutting Ritual over time.



ANCIENT DEHESA

The Jabugo Route, allows us to know the world of 100% Iberian acorn pig through a wonderful experience in an ancient Dehesa. There, we will know the management of the animal in its natural habitat by the hand of the Porquero, the person who knows and cares for them.

DRYING ROOMS AND ARTISAN CELLAR

The process of curing and maturation will be shown by the Master Jamonero in the drying rooms and artisan cellars, a process that lasts more than 3 years, and has been transmitted from generation to generation.







EXPERIENCE IN THE GRUTA DE LAS MARAVILLAS

In Aracena, we will have a Guided Tour of one of the area's greatest treasures, the **Gruta de las Maravillas**. The vast expanse of its lakes, the abundance and variety of calcareous formations, and its length make this underground complex an ensemble of great beauty.

It opened at the end of the 19th century in 1914 when it was opened to the public as the first tourist cave on the Spanish side.
